**Programme Objectives** 

1. French is one of the main international languages, spoken widely over the globe; hence the

knowledge of French equips learners with additional qualification and skills for their bright

future prospects.

2. To facilitate learners to comprehend and appreciate French language, literature, and the arts.

3. The acquisition of knowledge of French History, Culture and Civilization through French

language facilitates intercultural awareness, competences and enhances personal growth, and

professional development.

4. To enable learners to achieve language learning levels laid out by the Common European

Framework of Reference for Languages, developed by the European Council.

5. The syllabus is structured to suit the present day needs of the learners/students who wish to

study French language, which also includes learners from diverse educational backgrounds,

viz. engineers, doctors, lawyers, researchers, teachers, I.T. professionals, etc. Hence, the

latest text books that are prescribed cater to the learners' lingual requirements. These text

books are based on communicative and dynamic approach to learn the French language. The

CD's and DVD that accompany the text book provide oral comprehension exercises and

authentic videos that enhance language acquisition.

6. To motivate learners to continue further studies in French by pursuing higher studies in

French language and engage in research studies at higher levels.

### **Programme Outcomes**

### On completion of the programmes, the students will be able:

- 1. To acquire communicational competence and proficiency in French as specified by the internationally accepted Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
- 2. To gain a better understating and acquire a deeper knowledge of French civilization & culture through the study of French History & Geography, French & Francophone Literature.
- 3. To gain confidence to communicate fluently in French, in terms of Written and Oral Production, Written and Oral Comprehension, viz., in acquiring soft skills in French: speaking, reading, listening & comprehension. Thus, enhancing the learning, social, interpersonal, analytical and cognitive skills.
- 4. To be equipped to pursue higher studies in French.

### I. Eligibility

### 1.1. Minimum Eligibility for Admission to Certificate Course in French:

The candidates, who have successfully completed SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> class from Karnataka Board or other States of India or 10<sup>th</sup> class from CBSE/ICSC or any other equivalent from India or abroad are eligible for admission to the Certificate Course in French. This course is designed for those who have little or no prior knowledge of French. No upper Age Limit for admission to the Certificate Course in French.

#### 1.2. Minimum Eligibility for Admission to Diploma Course in French

The candidates, who have successfully completed Certificate Course in French from Karnatak University or any other university in India or its equivalent from abroad or should have studied French at PUC I & II /H.S.C I & II, etc/12th Class of CBSE/ICSC or its equivalent or should have completed A1 level from Alliance Française, are eligible for admission to the Diploma Course in French. No upper Age Limit for admission to the course.

#### 1.3. Minimum Eligibility for Admission to Advanced Diploma Course in French

The candidates, who have successfully completed Diploma from Karnatak University or any other Indian University or its equivalent from abroad or should have completed A2 from Alliance Française, are eligible for admission to the Advanced Diploma Course in French. No upper Age Limit for admission to the course.

## II. Duration of the Certificate course, Diploma Course and Advanced Diploma Course in French

- **2.1.** The duration of the Certificate Course in French is of **one year** duration comprising of two semesters of 90 working days each.
- **2.2.** The duration of the Diploma Course in French is of **one year** duration comprising of two semesters of 90 working days each.
- **2.3.** The duration of the Advanced Diploma Course in French is of **one year** duration comprising of two semesters of 90 working days each.
